All pool safety, fencing and all other DA requirements are the responsibility of LMCC.

Please contact Solo Water at the end of pool construction to arrange for the final inspection of the pool to verify compliance with Solo Water standard conditions.

To receive a connection certificate for a pool full compliance with the Standard Conditions must be demonstrated by the Pool Builder, including:

- All pool filters must be non-backwashable cartridge type filters.
- No connections to sewer what so ever.
- Stormwater pit/channel provided near the pool for managing excess pool water.
- Drinking water tap near the pool for pool filling.
- Engineering structural and zone of influence certification.

If the above is not installed ready for inspection at the time of the pool inspection, then follow up inspection(s) will be required and additional inspection fee(s) will be payable.

Pool inspections fees are applicable for each pool inspection. Including any follow up inspections to verify any non-compliances from the original inspection.
